CACHE Certificate in Playwork Level 2

The course consists of two units:

- Unit 1 Playwork Practice
- Unit 2 Health and Safety in a Playwork Setting.

You will cover:

Children and play, roles and responsibilities of a play worker, conflict resolution, dealing with accidents and emergencies, healthy eating and personal hygiene, supervision of trips and outings etc.

You can progress on to the CACHE Diploma in Playwork. Applicants for this course should be aged at least 16 and be employed in playwork or they would need a minimum of 60 hours' playwork experience through a voluntary placement.

NCFE Certificate for Teaching Assistants Stage 3

You will develop the skills you need to work as a teacher's assistant in a school. You will learn good practice and how to meet the needs of children in the school setting. If you successfully complete the course, you will gain a nationally recognised qualification for teaching assistants. To enrol for the course, you will need to undertake a short interview and you will need to have arranged a placement. Support in finding the placement is available.

Foundation Degree in Early Years (FdA) (Specialising in Playwork)

This is a two-year programme which helps develop knowledge, understanding and skills for career advancement while working with young children. It is aimed at candidates who hold a Level 3 qualification and are working in an Early Years setting. It will enable you to meet the changing circumstances in employment practices and possibly gain promotion to a management role.

The course is composed of a number of modules covering areas such as:

Contributing to the protection of children from abuse, working with other professionals, developing, implementing and evaluating specific plans and activities to meet the specific needs of children, managing sessions with groups of children, working with parents to enhance their children's learning and development, providing information to support decision making, developing own resources, enabling children to participate confidently and effectively in activities.

Optional units will focus on playwork.

To apply for this course you have to hold a Level 3 qualification in Early Years and Care and be in appropriate employment.

Assessment will be continuous but varied in format.
