Level 1

The Level 1 courses are designed to give you an introduction to working within the industry. It will provide you with a basic knowledge of the industry and an awareness and ability to use a range of hand tools.

Level 2

The Level 2 course qualifies an individual to work as a tradesperson within the industry. It is a certificate of competence that shows an employer that you have achieved a level of understanding and technical ability to work independently.

Level 3

This is the highest course that any tradesperson can achieve in the construction industry. The equivalent of the advanced craft certificate marks you out as a person who has a command of every aspect of the trade. Achievement of this award, linked to industrial experience will give you the opportunity to become a Licentiate of the City and Guilds and give you the status of Master Craftsman.
